ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2011-2012

The important activities / achievements of the Council during the period from 01.04.2011 to 31.03.2012 are mentioned hereunder:

1. LIBRARY BOOKS AND JOURNALS:

During the period under reference, 101 number of books, journals and reports have been procured for the Library bringing the total to 6615 books, reports and journals out of which 4485 volume are books and 2130 are journals.

2. THE THIRD PROF. AJIT KUMAR MITRA MEMORIAL LECTURE:

The 3rd Prof. Ajit Kumar Mitra Memorial Lecture was delivered by Prof. Adwait Kumar Mohanty on 4th July, 2011 at 5 P.M. in the Seminar Hall of COATS. Prof. Mohanty, Former RBI Chair Professor, Utkal University, Vani-Vihar Bhubaneswar delivered the talk on "Approaches to Tribal Development in India: An Overview". Dr. P.N. Kutty, Executive Trustee of IWS was the Chief Guest and Sri Sachin R. Jadhav, IAS, Collector, Koraput presided over the meeting.

3. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

A) M.Phil in Tribal Studies:

All the 16 students who appeared the theory papers in 2010 M.Phil Examination have passed their Theory papers. Till 31st March, 2012, 11 of them have submitted their dissertations to the University for valuation. The last date for submission of dissertation is 31.07.2012.

B) Ph.D Programme:

He completed his research works under the supervision of Dr. P.C. Mohapatro, Director, COATS.

Recognition to COATS as a Ph.D Centre has been accorded by the Berhampur University since January, 2011.

C) Publications:

The Ph.D dissertation entitled "Socio-Economic Development of a Primitive Tribal group of Orissa" by Dr. Bhagyalaxmi Mohapatra has been published by the end of June, 2011. The book was released by Sri Pyarimohan Mohapatra, Hon'ble M.P (R/S) and Chairman, COATS on 02.07.11 the day before the car festival.

D) Preparation of Block wise Monograph on Koraput District:

The work of preparation of Monograph on "Koraput Block" is in progress and it is expected that this work will be completed by the end of April, 2012.

4. PREPARATION OF THE DISTRICT PLANS AS TECHNICAL SUPPORT INSTITUTE:

The Planning and Coordination Department had entrusted COATS the task of Preparation of Annual Plans: 2012-13 and Five Year Perspective Plans: 2012-17 for Koraput and Nabarangpur Districts. The Rough Draft of Annual Integrated Plans: 2012-13 for both the districts have been submitted to P & C Department in the second week of February, 2012. The Five Year Perspective Plans are under preparation which will be placed for approval before the new District Planning Committee yet to be formed and so it will take some time for the Plans to be submitted to Government.

5. SEMINARS ORGANISED AND ATTENDED:

COATS in collaboration with the Indian Economic Association and the District Administration of Koraput organized a National Seminar on, "Challenges of Tribal Development in the Era of Post Globalisation" at Koraput on 7th and 8th

Seven participants from six States, six participants from May, 2011. Bhubaneswar and neighbouring districts of Puri and 20 delegates from different colleges of Koraput Region participated in the Seminars. On the whole 122 participants consisting of delegates, district level officers, academicians and press representatives participated in the Seminar. Twenty research papers were presented in the Seminar. A Souvenir was published on the occasion in which the synopsis of the papers presented in the Seminar as well as advertisements for raising funds to organize the Seminar in a befitting manner were included. A sum of Rs.2,23,500/- was raised in the form of donations (Rs.21,000.00) and (Rs.2,02,500.00) for publication advertisements. An expenditure of Rs.1,99,666.00 was incurred for the organization of the Seminar. The balance of Rs.24,340.00 including interest is in a separate Bank Account opened in the Andhra Bank.

6. INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT:

Skill Development Centre:

During the year 2011-12, 255 candidates were trained out of which 205 trained candidates have got placements in different export oriented Apparel Industries in Hyderabad, Chennai and Bangalore.

7. INDIRA GANDHI NATIONAL OPEN UNIVERSITY (IGNOU) CENTRE:

Under the auspices of IGNOU authorities a Special Study Centre is functioning in the premises of COATS since 2001-02 to facilitate spread of education among weaker sections of society who are not able to prosecute regular higher studies. Nine certificate courses, seven Diploma courses, four Degree

courses, seven Master Degree courses including MARD, MSO, MSW have been activated between July, 2005 cycle to July, 2008 cycle. During 2011-12 sessions the number of students on roll of IGNOU study centre, COATS stood at 402.
